Entry Requirement

Learner(s) must fulfil the following criteria to be allowed entry to Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Social Care Management;

- Graduate Diploma in Health and Social Care Management OR
- Relevant Honour Degree level qualification OR
- Any qualification equivalent to one of the above



Course Structure

The Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Social Care Management has total 9 units. Learners must have to earn 120 credit points to obtain the Level 7 Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Social Care Management.

- Unit 07: Managing Organisational Performance
- Unit 08: Managing Quality through Human Resource Management
- Unit 09: Research Methods for Health and Social Care Managers



Assessment

Assessment includes assignments, critical reviews and analysis which will be assessed according to the generic programme criteria provided in the assessment handbook for tutors.



Progression Route

Holders of Post Graduate Diploma will directly enter into the final stage of MSc in Health and Social Care Management from Liverpool John Moores University. Postgraduate Diploma in Health and Social Care Management will be considered for admission with 120 credits out of total 180 Credits onto the Liverpool John Moores University MSC in Health and Social Care Management. Learners have to apply for the APL for credit exemptions. Applicants have to do the following phase of the MSC Degree.

- Dissertation (60 Credits)
